

Dear Community Leader,

We are asking you to consider supporting the 20th Anniversary of the Sam Miller Celebration of Goodness festivities, "Welcome to Kindland". These festivities will consist of a virtual luncheon and awards ceremony at noon on Thursday, September 10th, a special supplement tribute book in the *Cleveland Jewish News* (9,000 households print distribution as well as expansive online distribution) on September 11th, and a broadcast TV airing of the awards ceremony on September 13th. Please see attached materials.

This year's event, titled, "Welcome to Kindland," will feature and honor awardees U.S. Senator Rob Portman, Ohio First Lady Fran DeWine, former Cleveland Mayor Mike White, Kristin Warzocha and the Greater Cleveland Food Bank, and the Hebrew Free Loan Association of NE Ohio. There will also be special segments dedicated to unsung heroes who have helped our community during the first outbreak of COVID-19. The award recipients will be receiving the Sam Miller Goodness Award and the Arnold R. Pinkney Award for Civic Leadership. The awards and their respective honorees are noted on the attached materials.

Both Sam Miller and Arnold Pinkney, who were good friends, colleagues and co-leaders of the community, envisioned Northeast Ohio as a community of goodness and kindness. Each of these men were pragmatic and realized that goodness and kindness were aspirational visions, but they were resolute that Northeast Ohio remain determined to get there. In 2001, Sam Miller asked Values-in-Action (Project Love) to host and sponsor this annual event and to expand it as needed. Arnold Pinkney assisted in its establishment and served as Project Love's board chair from 2009-2011.

This year's Celebration of Goodness also serves as the official launch of Values-in-Action's *Kindland* initiative. Combining the visions of Sam and Arnold, the goal is to make Cleveland known as Kindland, the kindest community in the nation. In Kindland, people treat each other with kindness, caring and respect. In Kindland, police and community are in-sync with core values and actions. In Kindland, neighbors help neighbors. In Kindland, the underserved are served. In Kindland, the values of kindness short-circuit and prevent negative activities — violence, bullying, racism and disrespect — from happening.

Some may feel a dramatic cultural shift is not realistic, but in the eyes of two strong leaders, Sam Miller and Arnold Pinkney — one black and one white — an entire community dedicated to kindness and goodness was not only possible but essential. One example of how kindness can tip an entire culture is the story of Mikey George. As the first mainstreamed Downs syndrome student at St. Edward High School, Mikey exuded kindness in his every action, and his kindness changed the culture of the school. Mikey passed away in 2019 from Leukemia. Appropriately, as part of Kindland and the Celebration of Goodness event, we are designating an award in his name - **The Mikey George Kindland Award**.

Please join us in supporting the 20th Anniversary of the Celebration of Goodness, honoring both our esteemed and unsung honorees, and introducing and welcoming Kindland into our great community.


